

IMPORTANT INFORMATION CONCERNING THE 2012 BES TUITION RAFFLE

1. This year we will be conducting a Reverse Raffle. The reverse raffle will take place on Friday, March 2, 2012, as part of the BES Parent Social and Auction. Rather than the first ticket drawn determining the winner of the tuition credit it will be the last ticket drawn. The purchaser/holder of a raffle ticket need not be present to win.
2. Participants of the 2011 Tuition Raffle with children still attending BES will be offered the opportunity to repurchase up to the quantity of tickets they purchased last year prior to the start of this year's general ticket sales. During the repurchase promotion the cost of a single raffle ticket will be \$75 per ticket – Buy Two Raffle Tickets, Get A Third Ticket Free.
3. At the end of the repurchase opportunity, general tickets sales will begin. The cost of a single raffle ticket is \$100.00. The maximum number of tickets sold for the raffle will be 200.
4. The first 199 raffle tickets will be sold for no less than \$75.00 each prior to the start of the BES Parent Social and Auction. If unsold tickets from the supply of 199 remain at the start of the BES Parent Social and Auction they could be sold as a combination and/or at a different price but not for less than this year's general sales established price of \$100.00 each.
5. From February 6th – February 10th, a “Buy 2 Raffle Tickets, Get A Third Ticket Free” promotion will be conducted. The “Free Third Ticket” is a promotional ticket and is accounted for separately from the 200 tickets available for sale. A maximum of 99 promotional tickets will be awarded for the entire raffle.
6. The maximum number of tickets participating in the raffle is 299 assuming all 200 tickets are sold and 99 promotional tickets are awarded.
7. Raffle tickets will be drawn from the raffle drum throughout the BES Parent Social and Auction.
8. At the point in which only four unselected tickets remain in the raffle drum the drawing of tickets will pause and the up to this point unsold 200th ticket will be sold by live auction to the highest bidder. The 200th ticket will then be added to the raffle drum so that the remaining contents in the drum will now consist of the last five tickets to be drawn.
9. A board containing a listing of all raffle tickets not drawn will be present and updated throughout the BES Parent Social and Auction.
10. A prize of \$500 Registration Fee Reimbursement will be awarded to the purchaser of the first raffle ticket drawn.
11. A prize of one week of BES Summer Camp (choice of *Morning Only Program* or *Total Camp Program*) will be awarded to the purchaser of the 50th ticket drawn.
12. A prize of \$250 Technology Fee Reimbursement will be awarded to the purchaser of the 100th raffle ticket drawn.
13. A prize of \$425 Book, Supplies and Activity Fee will be awarded to the purchaser of the 150th raffle ticket drawn.
14. A prize of at least \$6,000 awarded as a 2012-2013 school year Tuition Credit will be awarded to the purchaser of the last raffle ticket drawn.
15. Additional prizes will be awarded throughout the raffle. A listing of all prizes to be awarded will be posted at the BES Parent Social and Auction registration desk prior to the first draw of the raffle.
16. If the amount of the tuition credit received by the winning ticket holder is greater than the actual cost of tuition for the 2012-2013 school term, the remaining credit will be applied to the tuition for the 2013-2014 school term.
17. To receive tuition credit, the student must be enrolled or accepted at BES for the 2012-2013 school term. If a graduating 6th grader, tuition must be applied first to BES and then to the student's middle school tuition. Tuition credit is not redeemable, transferable, or refundable. Winner is responsible for all applicable taxes. Ticket purchases are not tax deductible. Ticket purchase is non-refundable. In the event that the holder of the winning ticket is not able to use the tuition credit, it will be awarded to the holder of the ticket that was drawn immediately prior to the winning ticket.
18. If the family of a graduating sixth grader wins the registration fee reimbursement, technology fee reimbursement, or the book, supply, and activity fee reimbursement, that amount must be applied first to BES and then to the student's tuition-based middle school.
