**Appetizers: (Pick one)**

- Visit a public library - Consider applying for your own library card if you don't already have one!
- Visit a Book Mobile
- Get a book recommendation from a friend or website
- Create a bookmark for a book that you have read this summer

**Beverages: (Pick one)**

- Read to a younger sibling/neighbor
- Read a graphic novel (comic book) or magazine
- Read for 30 minutes while on vacation
- Read poems that inspire you

**Main Courses: (Pick two)**

- (Required)** Read The Lightning Thief by Rick Riordan- If you have already read this then feel free to read any book by this author.

Additionally select one of the following:

- Read a grade level appropriate book of your choice - Write a book review, create a short Keynote presentation, book trailer, Wordle, or alternate ending.

- \_\_\_\_\_ Read a book that was turned into a movie (other than The Lightning Thief.) then watch the movie - Compare the two by using a Venn diagram.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Read a book set in a place you would like to visit or have visited. Create a travel brochure about the place in your book.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Read a 2016-2017 Sunshine State Book - Write a book review stating why someone should or should not read this book.

**Desserts: : (Pick one)**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Create a movie poster or piece of art for a book that you have read this summer
- \_\_\_\_\_ Create a scrapbook page about a book you read this summer
- \_\_\_\_\_ Recommend your favorite summer book to a friend or neighbor
- \_\_\_\_\_ Write a letter to your Language Arts teacher discussing your favorite book read this summer
